

Frequently Asked Questions

REGISTRATION OPENS JUNE 1ST! West Coast Auto Dealers Slam Specal: \$100 June 1-10 \$140 June 11-30 \$165 July 1-7 Registration Closes Midnight July 7, 2019 Team Brackets available July 10

YOUTH DIVISION REGISTRATION: Youth divisions will be sorted by age dependent upon player's age as of Saturday, July 13th 2019, school grade entering in September 2019, and registration demographics. Team profile will be based on age and grade level of the eldest player.

STUDENT ID: Proof of age and/or grade level is NOT required at time of check-in. However, in case of a game dispute, you will be asked to verify player information with either student ID, school report card OR birth certificate. It must be producible within 24 hours ONLY if there is a dispute. We recommend you have ID easily accessible. Photo ID is available at http://www.dol.wa.gov/driverslicense/gettingidcard.html.

CHECK IN: Richland Red Lion Hanford House. For local players team check in is Friday, July 12, 2019 from 5:00-8:00pm. For out of town players, team check in is Saturday morning, July 13, 2019 from 6:30-8:00am. Only one member is necessary to check in the team.

WAIVERS: Signed waivers are mandatory for each player. NOTE: if registered online, waivers have been automatically signed and submitted. For all other forms of registration, a signed waiver is required. Please download the waiver, have each player sign it, and submit at time of check-in. Registration cannot be completed without waivers. Release and Voluntary Waiver form available online under the RULES AND FORMS tab at see3slam.com. We will also have waiver forms available for completion at time of check in.

PLAYER CHANGES: Download the Player Change Form from the website under the RULES AND FORMS tab at see3slam. com. Complete and submit with \$20 payment. You may submit by email to contact@see3slam.com, BEFORE midnight Thursday, July 11, 2019 with credit card information included OR submit cash-only (no checks accepted) at time of check in. The new team player MUST FTT current team profile to be approved.

HOOP HEIGHTS: Grades 1-4:8' Grades 5 and up:10'

BASKETBALL SIZE: Basketballs will be provided for each court based on following criteria:

All grades 1-4 will use a 27.5" ball Boys grades 5-8 will use a 28.5" ball

Girls/Women grades 5 and up will use 28.5" ball Boys/Men grades 9 and up will use 29.0" ball Co-Ed brackets will use 29.0" ball If both teams agree to use a ball brought by a player of either team in any size, they are allowed to do so. If both teams cannot agree on a ball to play with, the provided tournament ball will be required.
