



Frequently Asked Questions

REGISTRATION OPENS JUNE 1ST! Three Day Early Bird Special: **\$133** June 1-3 - **\$165** June 4-24

YOUTH DIVISION REGISTRATION: Youth divisions will be sorted by age dependent upon player's age as of Saturday, July 11th 2026, **school grade entering in September 2026** and registration demographics. Team profile will be based on age and grade level of the eldest player.

STUDENT ID: Proof of age and/or grade level is NOT required at time of check-in. However, in case of a game dispute, you will be asked to verify player information with either student ID, school report card OR birth certificate. It must be producible within 24 hours ONLY if there is a dispute. We recommend you have ID easily accessible. Photo ID is available at <https://dol.wa.gov/id-cards/get-id-card>

CHECK IN: Registration on stage in John Dam Plaza, corner of Jadwin and Knight for local players team check in is Friday, July 10 2026 from 5:00- 8:00pm. For out of town players, team check in is Saturday morning, July 11 2026 from 6:30-8:00am at **Score Central in park north of Center Court**. Only one member is necessary to check in the team but all teams must be checked in PRIOR TO START OF TOURNAMENT ON SATURDAY July 11, 2026. **ALL team players registered in Under 6 Ft Division (Standard, Competitive, High School) must have their height verified and certified prior to playing their first game.**

NEW TEAM VERIFICATION PROCESS - PLEASE READ

At team check-in, each team will be required to designate **ONE TEAM REPRESENTATIVE**. This individual may be the team-coach, team-captain, or team-parent who will not only wear a tournament-issued wristband for the duration of the tournament BUT will be expected to be in attendance for each scheduled team game. No team will be officially checked-in nor be allowed to play without first designating the **TEAM REPRESENTATIVE**.

WAIVERS: Signed waivers are mandatory for each player. **NOTE: if registered online, waivers have been automatically signed and submitted.**

PLAYER CHANGES: Download the Player Change Form from the website under the RULES AND FORMS tab at see3slam.com. Read carefully before completing and submit with \$10 payment thru June 30th or \$20 payment up to 11:59pm **Thursday, July 9th**. Please submit by email to contact@see3slam.com. **NO PLAYER CHANGES ACCEPTED AFTER 11:59pm Thursday, July 9th.** The new team player **MUST FIT** current team profile to be approved and no player changes permitted after the start of tournament play.
